### **WEST CORRIDOR TO DONATE RECYCLED HOME APPLIANCES TO HABITAT FOR HUMANITY**

**Denver, September 18, 2009** – Denver Transit Construction Group (DTCG), the West Corridor Light Rail construction contractor, and the Regional Transportation District (RTD) will be donating used refrigerators and stoves to the Habitat for Humanity Home Improvement Outlet stores. The appliances were left in the apartment buildings that RTD acquired for the West Corridor light rail station and parking structure near 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Sheridan Blvd. “RTD and DTCG are pleased to be able to put these appliances to good use, while helping a great organization like Habitat for Humanity”, said Jon Brazeal, Project Engineer for DTCG. Volunteers from all three organizations will be loading the appliances on trucks to take to the Denver and Wheat Ridge Habitat for Humanity stores on Saturday, September 19 from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. For more information contact Kathy Berumen at 303-626-6762.

The 12.1-mile West Corridor light rail project is the first of the FasTracks corridors to start construction. The West Corridor line will operate between Denver Union Station in downtown Denver and the Jefferson County Government Center in Golden; serving Denver, Lakewood, the Denver Federal Center, Golden and Jefferson County. The corridor is scheduled to open to the public in 2013.

FasTracks is RTD’s voter-approved, 12-year program to expand rail and bus service throughout the RTD service area. FasTracks will create six new rail corridors, extend three existing corridors, build 18 miles of bus rapid transit service, add 21,000 new parking spaces, redevelop Denver Union Station and expand bus service across the eight-county District.
