ROAD CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR FASTRACKS WEST CORRIDOR CONSTRUCTION

Lakewood, May 7, 2010 – West Corridor construction will close traffic lanes on the following roadways:

Closures:

Sunday, May 9

- One lane of the off ramp from westbound 6th Avenue to Simms/Union will be closed on Sunday, May 9 beginning at 8:00 p.m. until Monday, May 10 at 5:30 a.m.

Monday, May 10 – Saturday, May 15

- One lane of the off- ramp from westbound 6th Avenue to Simms/Union will be closed from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 pm daily

Monday, May 10 – Friday, May 14

- One lane of eastbound 6th Avenue at Ulysses Street will be closed from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. daily

Monday, May 10 – Thursday, May 13

- One lane of eastbound 6th Avenue between Simms/Union and Indiana will be closed from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Thursday, May 13 – Friday April 14

- All lanes of westbound 6th Avenue at Indiana Street will be closed from 9:00 p.m. Thursday, May 13 until 5:30 a.m. Friday, May 14
 - Traveling motorists will be detoured off of 6th Avenue at Indiana but will be able to cross Indiana and access 6th Avenue right away via the westbound on-ramp at Indiana.

- The on-ramp from Indiana to eastbound 6th Avenue will be closed from 12:00 a.m. to 5:30 a.m.
- The on ramp from Indiana to westbound 6th Avenue will be closed from 12:00 a.m. to 5:30 a.m.

FasTracks is RTD's voter-approved transit program to expand rail and bus service throughout the RTD service area. FasTracks will build 122 miles of commuter rail and light rail, 18 miles of bus rapid transit service, add 21,000 new parking spaces, redevelop Denver Union Station and redirect bus service to better connect the eight-county District. The FasTracks investment initiative is projected to create more than 10,000 jobs during the height of construction, and will pump billions of dollars into the regional economy.
